Flight hours experience for flight ops inspector is aligned with Doc 10070: A flight operations inspector, for example, should hold or have held a pilot licence/rating at least equal to the licence/rating for which assessments are conducted and have relevant experience in the aircraft operations subject to oversight

Air carrier operations inspectors must have a minimum of 1,500 total flight hours in multi-engine aircraft with takeoff weight of more than 12,500 pounds General aviation operations inspectors must meet the same flight hours and experience requirements All operations inspectors must have pilot experience and required certificates and ratings,
